All fixed stations wishing to check in please check in according to the first letter of the suffix of your call and give your name and location. Please use standard phonetics.

Fixed stations Alpha through Golf please call net control.

Fixed stations Alpha through Zulu please call net control.

Net control recognizes the following stations: (List of stations G—Z).

We will now begin the informal portion of the net. (Call the stations A—Z in turn for any comments **Start With Mobiles**)
